

## CHAPTER FIVE – PERMELIA HELEN MCGEE

### *Generation No. 3*

**1. PERMELIA HELEN<sup>3</sup> MCGEE** (*JOHN SIMPSON<sup>2</sup>, JOHN<sup>1</sup>*) was born March 11, 1847 in state of Kentucky, and died June 09, 1911 in Wimberley, Hays County, Texas. She married **JOHN CHATFIELD ROBERTS** March 20, 1866 in Wilson County, Texas. He was born September 20, 1845 in Meriwether County, Georgia, and died May 28, 1913 in Wimberley, Hays County, Texas.

Notes for PERMELIA HELEN MCGEE:

Permelia McGee was the fifth child of John and Ann McGee, named after her grandmother, Permelia (Shelton) Hawkins.

The following letter, dated February 11, 1893, was written by Permelia (McGee) Roberts, who lived in Hays County, Texas, to her daughter, Barbara Ann Shuptrine, who lived in Houston County, Texas. Barbara Ann was called "Bobie" by her family. The original was written in pencil on lined paper. (Letter in the possession of a great-granddaughter, Lola Post)

Mrs. Bobie Shuptrine

Dear Bobie. I guess you think I am not going to write at all. Alice has been staying with Phronie. She has been very sick but is up now. Pearl, Elmo, Jim go to school so you know I have no time to write. Edna is staying here going to school with the children. Alice came home yesterday. We are all very well. Annie and Jim Roberts have been up on a visit. Your Aunt Mollie & Grandpa and Ike went back with them. I don't know how long Mollie will stay. I guess Ike will stay all the year. Ella R. staid several days with me last week. Annie told me to tell you that she had a picture for you and when you wrote to her she would write and send it to you. You must be sure and write to her, she thinks so much of you. Every day she would say I do wish cousin Bob would come. She seemed to be hurt because you didn't write to her.

Sallie and Mr. Shuptrine are well. Ella Shuptrine was here one day last week. I want to go to town tommorrow and see how Phronie is getting on. I wish you and Calvin lived nearer. I hate for you to live where there are so many negroes. Don't never stay by yourself, it is dangerous, no telling what might happen to you. Calvin please don't never leave her alone all night.

I will send your papers. Your GrandMa McGee sent me Pa's gold speks. John Gary was here last week. John is a good boy. I have not planted any garden yet, only button onions & I planted some cabbage and tomatoes in boxes. I have but too b\_\_\_s setting. Mr. Ezelle bought Mr. Colwells place. Mr. Colwell has gone to Bee County. I would rather you lived in Bee County than where you do. Mrs. Townsend has not come back from San Antonio yet, waiting for Frank to have a frolic. I have been washing all day and I am sure tired. Edna and Alice helped me. We have had a very cold norther. Led is working with Mr. Ezelle. Tell Frank \_\_\_ is as bad as ever, she often talks about you. Doc has been sowing oats. Today write me a long letter. Mrs. Ezelle is going to send you some flower seed, I wish you would send me some in your next letter. Alice brought me a sack full of \_\_\_ bushes from Phoenix. I set them out.

Bobie, please promise me you will never stay alone at night any more. The negroes are going to cause a great deal of trouble. They burnt one in Paris where Miss Mollie Price came from last week. I will close as I am sleepy. Write soon, and a long letter. When Calvin is gone all night you go and stay with Dave's wife. I will be so uneasy

about you. Give my best love to Calvin and Willie and little old Frank. Tell him Grandma wants to see him so bad.

(Note: In the above letter "GrandMa McGee" was Permelia's mother, Ann (Hawkins) McGee, who lived in Kentucky. Permelia's father, Rev. John Simpson McGee, died three years earlier in 1890, and Ann McGee must have sent Permelia her father's gold spectacles as a memento.

Notes for JOHN CHATFIELD ROBERTS:

There has been some confusion as to the correct first name for Mr. Roberts. In Harry Shuptrine's book, "The Shuptrine Family," published in 1992, he identifies Mr. Roberts as Dr. James Chatfield Roberts. However, in the U.S. Census reports of 1870, 1880, 1900 and 1910 (see below), Mr. Roberts was always listed as John C. Roberts, a farmer.

*The 1880 census for Precinct No. 1, Hays County, Texas lists John C. Roberts, age 35, head of the household and a farmer, his wife, **Permelia**, age 31, a daughter, Bobreallis, age 13, a daughter, Fronie, age 8, a son, John M., age 7, a daughter, Alice, age 5, a son, James, age 3, and a son, Elmer, age 1.*

*The 1900 census for Justice Precinct No. 4, Hays County, Texas lists John C. Roberts, age 51, head of the household and a farmer, his wife, **Permelia**, age 51, a daughter, Alice L., age 25, a son, Elmo J., age 20, a daughter, Pearl, age 18, a son, Charles M., age 15 (?), and a daughter, Lydia M., age 11.*

*The 1910 census for San Marcos, Hays County, Texas shows John C. Roberts, age 64, his wife, **Permelia**, age 61, and their daughter, Myrtle, age 20, all living in the household of their daughter and son-in-law, Barbara and Calvin Shuptrine.*

She married **(1) WILLIAM FRANKLIN MCCLAREN** abt. 1886. She married **(2) CALVIN SHUPTRINE** November 06, 1892 in the state of Texas, son of NICHOLAS SHUPTRINE and REBECCA ALLEN. He was born January 04, 1867 in Grapeland, Houston County, Texas, and died June 20, 1948 in San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas.

Notes for BARBARA ANN ROBERTS:

Barbara Ann Roberts was called "Bobbie" by her friends and family. She died September 21, 1936 at her home in San Antonio, Texas. She was living with her daughter and son-in-law, Callie and Wendell Rees at the time.

SHUPTRINE - Mrs. Barbara Ann Shuptrine died at her residence, 232 Kendalia Avenue, Monday morning. Survivor, husband, Calvin Shuptrine; three sons; three daughters; three sisters and one brother. The body will be sent to Wimberley, Tex., Tuesday morning by the Shelley Funeral Home. Definite arrangements will be announced later.

## Notes for CALVIN SHUPTRINE:

Before he married Barbara Ann Roberts, Calvin Shuptrine was married to Eliza Ann Harrison, who died in childbirth on June 18, 1890, in Houston County, Texas. Calvin and Eliza Ann had one son, William Daniel "Willie" Shuptrine, born June 18, 1890. Barbara had been previously married to William F. McClaren, and she had one son from that marriage, William Franklin McClaren. Both of the boys, Willie and Frank, were listed as part of the Shuptrine household in the 1900 census:

*The 1900 census for Precinct No. 3, Houston County, Texas lists Calvin Shuptrine, age 34, head, a farmer, b. Jan. 1866 in Texas, his wife, **Barbara**, age 32, b. June 1867 in Texas, a son, Frank W., age 12, b. March 1888 in Texas, a son, Willie D., age 9, b. June 1890 in Texas, a son, Chatfield, age 4, b. Aug. 1895 in Texas, a daughter, Amelia R., age 2, b. Dec. 1897 in Texas, and a daughter, Frany M., age 5 months, b. Dec. 1899 in Texas. Also living in the household was his father, Nicholas D. Shuptrine, age 77, b. Aug. 1823 in Georgia, and a widower. (Note: Chatfield, Amelia and Frany (Fronie) are Barbara and Calvin's children. Frank was Barbara's son from her previous marriage, and Willie was Calvin's from his previous marriage.)*

Also living in the household were father-in-law, John C. Roberts, age 64, mother-in-law, Melie Roberts, age 61, and sister-in-law, Myrtle Roberts, age 20, single, employed as an operator at the telephone company. Everyone except Permelia was born in Texas.*

*The 1920 census for Precinct 5, Medina County, Texas lists Calvin Shuptrine, age 53, head of the household and a farmer, his wife, **Barbara**, age 52, a daughter, Mrs. Fronie Wipff, age 21, widow and clerk in a dry goods store, a grandson, Daniel Wipff, age 2 years, 3 months, a son, Robert C. Shuptrine, age 17, a clerk in a dry goods store, a son, Rex O. Shuptrine, age 16, delivery boy for a dry goods store, a son, Leroy W. Shuptrine, age 14, and a daughter, Callie O. Shuptrine, age 11.*

*The 1930 census for Precinct No. 3, Bandera County, Texas lists Calvin Shuptrine, age 63, head, a merchant in a meat market, and his wife, **Barbara A.**, age 62.*

SHUPTRINE - Calvin Shuptrine, age 82, of Bandera, Texas, passed away in local hospital in this city June 20. Survived by daughters, Mrs. Callie Rees of Bandera, Texas; Mrs. Amelia Hodges, Eugene, Oregon; Mrs. Frances Oaks, Wilmington, Calif.; sons, George C., Natalia, Texas; Robert C., Millett, Texas; Lee Roy, Kingsville, Texas; and William Shuptrine of Victoria, Texas; 19 grandchildren; 7 great-grandchildren. Remains will lie in state at the chapel of the Southside Funeral Home until 2 p.m. Tuesday and then taken overland for services Wednesday at 3 p.m. from the Rogers and Rennington Funeral Home, San Marcos, Texas. Interment in Wimberley Cemetery, Wimberley, Texas. Arrangements by Southside Funeral Home, 6301 South Flores St. (in Harlandale).

*The 1910 census for Precinct No. 1, Hays County, Texas lists Henry Wilson, age 49 (?), head, employed as a farm overseer; his wife, **Phrona**, age 40; a son, Johnnie S., age 19, farm laborer; a son, Jesse M., age 13; and a daughter, Blanche L., age 15 months.*

*The 1920 census for San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas lists H. E. Wilson, age 50, head, a truck farmer; his wife, **Fronia**, age 49; and a daughter, Blanche, age (?). The family resided on Gladstone Street.*

By 1930, Henry and Phronie Wilson were living with their son, John H. Wilson, and his family. John Wilson operated a hotel in Wilson County, Texas. Henry and Phronie's daughter, Blanche, was also living there with her family.

*The 1930 census for Precinct No. 6, Wilson County, Texas lists John H. Wilson, age 38, head, an engineer in the hotel business; his wife, Lillie, age 28; a son, Harland, age 14; a son, J. *The 1920 census for New Braunfels, Comal County, Texas lists **Jack Roberts**, age 48, head, employed as an electrician; his wife, Ida, age 39; and a daughter, Adaline Kessler, age 15. The family resided on Mill Street. (Note: The daughter was probably from Ida's previous marriage.)*

He put in 40 years; a leadership award was named to honor him.

At one time the highest ranking civilian at Kelly AFB, Don Lee was revered for nurturing professionals, advancing the careers of women and minorities, and supporting the Air Force around the globe.



Lee, 78, died of cancer at his home in Helotes on Thursday. A member of the Senior Executive Service, he retired from Kelly in 1988 as director of material management, San Antonio Air Logistics Center. He had worked at Kelly for 40 years.

His position was the civilian equivalent of a one-star general. The Senior Executive Service is a civilian corps of executives that oversees federal agencies.

"To the people who worked at Kelly, Don Lee was as big to them as McD was at USAA," said Steve Doneghy, referring to retired Air Force Brig. Gen. Robert F. McDermott, chairman emeritus of USAA, who died Aug. 28.

Doneghy, who retired in 1999 as deputy director of propulsion at Kelly, said Lee was so highly thought of that the Don Lee Leadership Award was established to recognize civil service employees who demonstrated leadership, integrity and professionalism.

Retired Air Force Maj. Gen. Paul Bielowicz, a former commander of the Air Logistics Center, said Lee was "one of the most effective, respected and admired members of the Senior Executive Service to ever serve at Kelly."

"Don was a giant of a man," Bielowicz said. "He was a mentor to literally hundreds of people. He nurtured their careers and he played significant roles in support of the Air Force not just at Kelly but around the globe because his people had worldwide logistics activity."

Lee was demanding but extremely fair, said retired Air Force Brig. Gen. Robert Murdock, Kelly's last commander. "Don recognized performance, and if you performed, Don Lee took care of you," Murdock said.

In operation since the early days of military aviation, Kelly closed in July 2001, six years after it was ordered shut by the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Commission, commonly called BRAC.

Lee served two years with the Navy Submarine Service and in 1948 began a lengthy career in civil service at Kelly. He was a graduate of the federal government's development center for senior executives, the Federal Executive Institute in Charlottesville, Va., and of the Senior Executive Fellows program for senior-level officials at the Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University.

After leaving Kelly, Lee established a business that did work for the Defense Department. As the day Kelly was to close approached, many of the people who had worked with Lee began to retire or move out of state. "He made it a point to come to every retirement ceremony. It made a tremendous impression on me," Murdock said.

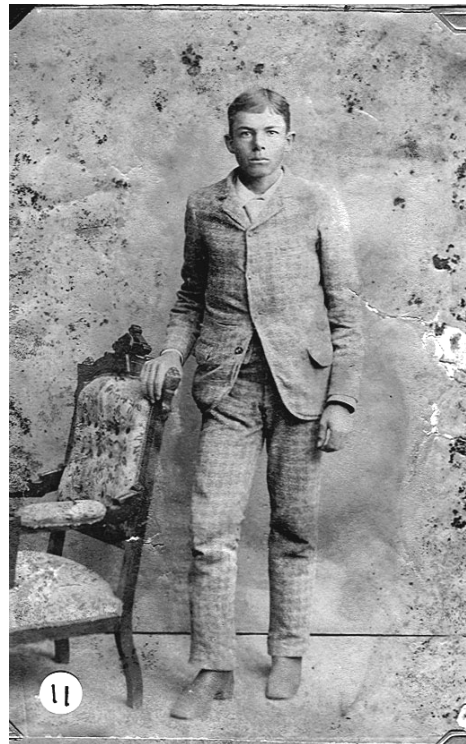

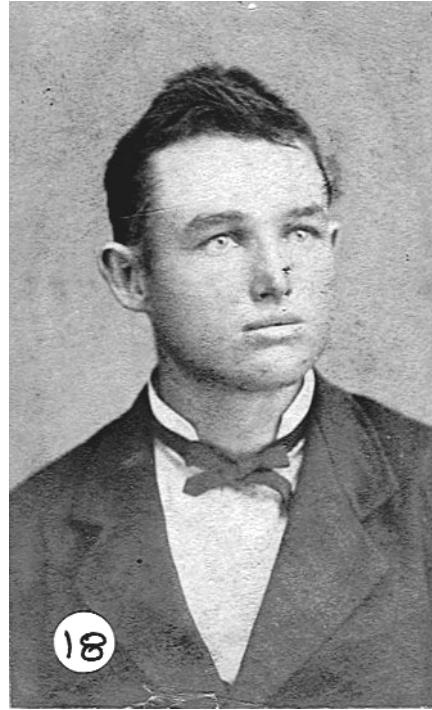

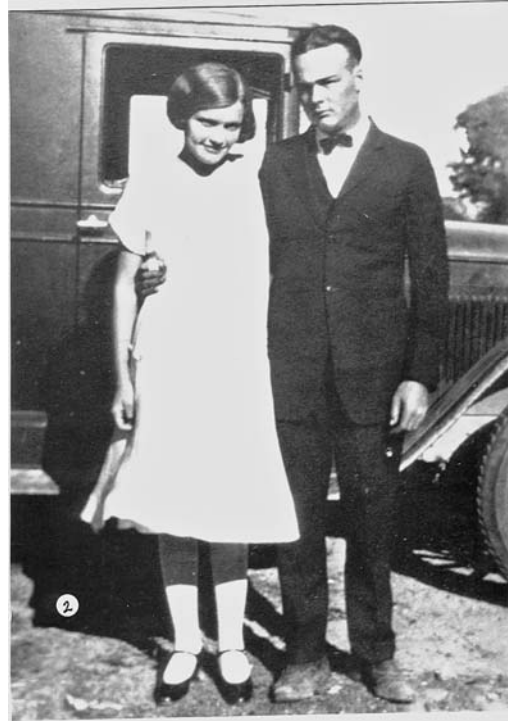

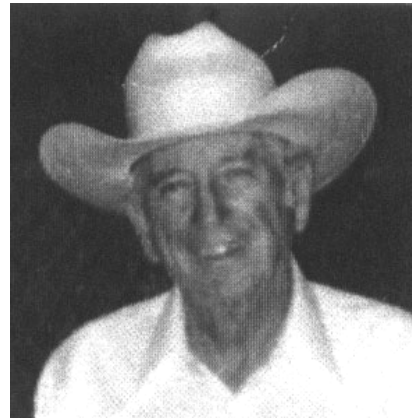
