### CHAPTER TEN

# Mary "Polly" Nichols and Descendants

### Generation No. 2

**1. MARY "POLLY"** NICHOLS (*JOHN*<sup>2</sup>, *UNKNOWN*<sup>1</sup>) was born February 22, 1811 in Mercer County, Kentucky, and died August 27, 1883 in Barren County, Kentucky. She married **JOHN JAMES "JACK" PURSLEY** March 24, 1829 in Barren County, Kentucky, son of WILLIAM PURSLEY and MARY BUCKLEY. He was born August 02, 1805 in Amherst County, Virginia, and died April 22, 1883 in Barren County, Kentucky.

Notes for MARY "POLLY" NICHOLS:

Mary "Polly" Nichols was born February 22, 1811 in Mercer County, Kentucky. We know she was born in Mercer because her father was named on the Mercer County personal property tax rolls for that year. She would have been only one year old when her family moved 100 miles west to settle in Barren County. Polly was the ninth child born to John and Nancy Nichols, but just their second daughter. When she was 18 years old, she married John James Pursley on March 24, 1829, in Barren County, and together they would have seven children. She and her husband both died the same year, in 1883, and are buried in the Matthews Family Cemetery in Barren County. Polly Pursley was 72 years old when she died, and her husband was 77.

Notes for JOHN JAMES "JACK" PURSLEY:

John James "Jack" Pursley was born in Amherst County, Virginia on August 2, 1805, the first child of William Pursley and Mary Elizabeth Buckley. His parents were probably acquainted with the Burch brothers, Leonard and John, who also lived in Amherst County at the same time, and they may have even known John Nichols as well, since he and Nancy resided there from 1795 until 1800. At any rate, it seems likely that by the time the Pursley's settled on Fallen Timber Creek in Barren County, Kentucky, there already existed a connection between the Pursley's, the Burch's and the Nichols.

In a deed made on January 1, 1856, William Anderson sold a certain tract of land located on the waters of Fallen Timber Creek which contained 9 acres for the sum of \$9 cash-n-hand. (Deed Book X, page 339, Barren County Clerk's Office.)

In a deed made on September 23, 1867, John J. Pursley purchased from M. H. Dickinson, Commissioner for the Barren County Court, a 69 acre tract located on the waters of Fallen Timber Creek for the sum of \$303. Because of an equity lawsuit, the land was ordered to be sold at public auction on April 15, 1867, and Pursley was the highest bidder. The land was the same as conveyed to Ann S. Matthews, now deceased, by John Peden in a deed dated February 21, 1860. (Deed Book 5, page 629, Barren County Clerk's Office.)

In a deed recorded in the Barren County Clerk's Office on December 17, 1870, two tracts of land located on Fallen Timber Creek, one tract containing 85 acres and the other tract containing 50

acres, were sold at public auction to S. H. Boles for the sum of \$677. The land was directed by the Barren County Court to be sold as a result of an equity suit following the death of William Pursley, and was the same land upon which he lived and died. After the sale, an order was entered into directing the commissioner to execute a deed of conveyance to S. H. Boles from the following: John J. Pursley, Joseph T. Pursley, Amanda Matthews and Anderson Matthews, Virginia Peden and B. S. Peden, William J. Pursley, Mary Burch, Landon Burch, Sarah Nichols and Joseph W. Nichols, J. M. Bailey, A. Bailey, Virginia Roberts and \_\_\_\_\_ Roberts, her husband, Judia Pursley, Rousseau Pursley and Nancy S. Pursley, by M. H. Dickinson, Commissioner of the Barren County Court. (Deed Book 7, page 397.)

In January of 1879, Joshua Pursley, the oldest son of Jack and Polly Pursley, was killed in an encounter with a wild bore hog. He was only 46 years old when he died, leaving behind his wife, also named Polly, and their three children. In a deed made in May 1879, Jack Pursley and his wife, Mary, conveyed to Joan Pursley, J. J. Pursley and Judia Pursley, all children of Joshua Pursley, deceased, a 42 acre tract of land situated on the waters of Fallen Timber Creek in Barren County, Kentucky. According to the deed, J. J. Pursley sold to Joshua Pursley, his son, during his lifetime, the same land for \$150 for which a receipt was acknowledged, but a deed was never issued, and whereas it is only fair and just that the said children of Joshua Pursley should have and be entitled to have the land, and that Mary T. Pursley, widow of said Joshua Pursley, is also entitled to her lifetime interest in said land. (Deed Book 14, page 315,)

Jack Pursley died on April 22, 1883, at the age of 77 years old, followed four months later by his wife, Polly, on August 27th. In a deed made on February 27, 1884, the heirs of J. J. Pursley, deceased, conveyed to William E. Peden, their rights and title to a certain tract of land located on the Tompkinsville Road, Barren County, Kentucky, containing 52 1/2 acres. (Deed Book 19, page 622.)

**2.** NANCY JANE<sup>4</sup> PURSLEY (MARY "POLLY"<sup>3</sup> NICHOLS, JOHN<sup>2</sup>, UNKNOWN<sup>1</sup>) was born January 02, 1830 in Barren County, Kentucky, and died November 12, 1911 in Barren County, Kentucky. She married JAMES H. BARBOUR March 29, 1853 in Barren County, Kentucky, son of JAMES BARBOUR and RUTH? He was born May 1830 in the state of North Carolina, and died February 04, 1907 in Barren County, Kentucky.

### Notes for NANCY JANE PURSLEY:

At some point between 1880 and 1887, Nancy Jane Barbour and her husband, James Barbour, were divorced. The 1900 census for District No. 3, Temple Hill, Barren County, Kentucky lists N. J. Barbour, age 70, head of the family, divorced, a son, U. T., age 35, a farmer, and a son, J. S., age 33, a house carpenter. According to the census report, eight of Nancy Jane's ten children were still living. Meantime, James H. Barbour had married for the second time and was raising another family. Living in the household immediately next door to Nancy Jane was her daughter, Julia Ann Matthews, a widow, with two of her sons.

The 1870 census for Glasgow Precinct, Barren County, Kentucky listed James H. Barbour, age 40, a farmer and head of the household, his wife, Nancy, age 40, a son, George R. T., age 16, a daughter, Mary M. M., age 14, a daughter, Julie A. E., age 12, a son, John J., age 10, a son, Lincoln, age 8, a son, Hawkins, age 8, a son, Union U. T., age 6, a son, Stanton G., age 3, and an unnamed son, age 2 months. The family's real estate was appraised at \$1000 and their personal estate was valued at \$500.

The 1880 census for Saunders Precinct, Barren County, Kentucky listed James K. Barbour, age 50, a farmer and head of the household, his wife, Nancy J., age 50, a son, George R., age 26, a daughter, Mary M., age 24, a son, John J., age 20, a son, Lincoln, age 18, a son, Hawkins, age 18, a son, Union T., age 14, a son, Joshua S., age 13, and a son, Jabus W., age 10.

James Barbour and his wife, Nancy Jane, were divorced sometime between 1880 and 1887. The 1900 census for District No. 3, Temple Hill, Barren County, Kentucky lists J. H. Barbour, age 70, a farmer and head of the household, his wife, A. E., age 43, a son, C. M., age 12, a daughter, N. F., age 9, and a daughter, S. A., age 4 years. James and his second wife, A. E., had been married for approximately 13 years, and three of their four children were still living.

Stout, age 37, a farmer and head of the household, his wife, Mary E., age 39, a son, Ephraim B., age 17, a daughter, Julia T., age 16, a son, William S. B., age 13, a daughter, Nancy G., age 11, a son, Daniel J., age 6, a daughter, Sallie A. B., age 5, and a son, Joshua S., age 11 months.

Daniel Stout was missing from the household at the time of the 1880 census, and his wife, Mary E., was listed as the head of the family. For Glasgow Junction, Barren County, Kentucky the report listed Mary E. Stout, age 49, keeping house and farming, Ephraim B., age 26, working on the farm, a son, Sam L. B., age 23, working at oil wells, a son, Joshua L., age 10, a son, Daniel J., age 16, working on the farm, and a daughter, Sally B., age 15.

The 1900 census for District No.3, Temple Hill, Barren County, Kentucky listed D. J. Stout, age 68, a farmer and head of the family, and his wife, Mary, age 69. The couple had been married for approximately 48 years, and only six of their eight children were still living.

The 1910 census for Glasgow, Barren County, Kentucky listed Daniel Stout, age 77, and his wife, Bettie, age 49. The couple had been married for about three years, the second marriage for both. They lived next door to his son, D. James Stout, who owned a hotel in Glasgow.

Obituary of DANIEL J. STOUT (from The Glasgow Times, Glasgow, Kentucky.)

Mr. Daniel J. Stout died at his home in the Oleoak country last Wednesday of causes incident to old age, he being eighty years old at his death. Before advancing years disabled him, Mr. Stout was known as the best shot, and greatest squirrel hunter in Barren County, always shooting his squirrel through the head with a rifle. He was a quiet, good man and citizen, and a member of the Baptist church.

The remains were interred at Poplar Springs Thursday last.

Notes for JOSHUA DAVIS PURSLEY:

He died at the age of 46. He was mortally wounded around Christmas-time by a wild bore hog in the Poplar Springs area. He killed and cured hogs for a living. Documents state that he lived in pain for a short while after his encounter with the bore and knew that he was dying. He called for his brothers and sisters to stay with him until the end, and they were all there when he died, apparently of peritonitis.

The 1870 census for Glasgow Precinct, Barren County, Kentucky listed Joshua D. Pursley, age 37, a farmer and head of the household, his wife, Mary, age 37, a daughter, Joan, age 11, a son, John J., age 9, a daughter, Judie M., age 6, and a daughter, Mary R., age 3 months. Their real estate was valued at \$800 and personal property at \$500. Joshua Pursley's sister, Mary, lived on the neighboring farm with her husband, Daniel J. Stout.

The 1880 census for Saunders Precinct, Barren County, Kentucky listed Mary R. Pursley, age 47, head of the household, a widow, a son, John J., age 19, farming, and a daughter, Judia K., age 16.

By 1900, Mary Pursley was living in the home of her son, John J. Pursley, and his family. The 1900 census for District No.3, Temple Hill, Barren County, Kentucky listed John J. Pursly, age 39, a house carpenter and head of the household, his wife, J. K., age 29, a son, J. S., age 10, and a son, Herbert, age 8. Also living with the family was his mother, Mary Pursley, age 68, a widow. According to the census report, only three of Mary's eight children were still living.

John Barlow died sometime between 1874 and 1880, and Missinia Barlow married again to William Slaughter. The 1880 census for Glasgow Junction, Barren County, Kentucky listed Missinia Slaughter, age 39, head of the household, keeping house, a daughter, Lucinda Barlow, age 19, helping to keep house, a son, Joseph Barlow, age 17, working on the farm, a son, Powell Barlow, age 16, working on the farm, a son, Charles Barlow, age 9, working on the farm, and a son, Kenny Barlow, age 6. Also living in the home and listed as "other" was William Slaughter, age 60, a farmer. (Note: It is assumed from the 1880 census report that Messina Barlow was married to William Slaughter, although he was not listed as her husband. Also, the census report listed all of her children as "step-children" of Messina Slaughter, which is incorrect.)

#### Notes for JOHN T. BARLOW:

John Barlow was listed in the 1850 census along with three children, and it is assumed that he was a widower. The 1850 census for Barren County, Kentucky listed John T. Barlow, a farmer and head of the household, a son, Franklin, age 8, a daughter, Sis, age 7, and a son, John, age 4. Also living in the home was Nancy Duff, age 50.

On March 1, 1859, John Barlow married Missinia Pursley, who had previously lived with her parents on the farm next door to Barlow's. The 1860 census for District No. 1, Barren County, Kentucky listed John T. Barlow, age 48, a farmer and head of the household, his wife, "Mecina," age 23, a son, Frank, age 18, a daughter, A , age 15, and a son, John, age 13.

The 1870 census for Glasgow Precinct, Barren County, Kentucky listed John T. Barlow, age 60, a farmer and head, his wife, Missina, age 33, keeping house, a daughter, Luanda, age 8, a son, Joseph H., age 6, a son, Powell S., age 5, and a son, Charles M., age 6 months. The Barlow's real estate was valued at \$6000 and personal property at \$500.




