CHAPTER FOURTEEN

Eliza Jane Nichols and Descendants

Generation No. 2

1. ELIZA JANE³ NICHOLS (*JOHN*², *UNKNOWN*¹) was born abt. 1818 in Barren County, Kentucky, and died 1850 in Barren County, Kentucky. She married **ROBERT H. "BOBBY" LYONS** August 07, 1839 in Barren County, Kentucky, son of JOSEPH LYONS and ELIZABETH NORVELL. He was born May 04, 1818 in Barren County, Kentucky, and died November 20, 1897 in Hart County, Kentucky.

Notes for ELIZA JANE NICHOLS:

Little is known about Eliza Jane Nichols, the youngest child of John and Nancy Nichols. The exact date of her birth has never been determined, although it was probably mid 1818 to early 1819. She married Robert H. Lyons in August of 1839, and their marriage bond is on file at the Barren County, Kentucky Circuit Clerk's Office. However, there is no accompanying note from her father on file with the marriage bond granting her permission to marry, which, unless it was lost, suggests that she was 21 years old at the time of her marriage. If true, that would make her birthday prior to August of 1818. She would have been married approximately 11 years before her death in early 1850 at about 32 years of age. The 1850 U.S. Census for Barren County lists only Robert Lyen, age 31, and the couple's six children: Martha A., age 9, Mary R., age 7, William J., age 5, Susan E., age 4, America, age 1, and Nancy J., age 5 months. Although the census count actually began in Barren County in mid July, the first official day for the 1850 census was June 1, and all deaths and births reported on the census record were effective as of June 1. Assuming the census information was correct and the youngest child, Nancy J., was truly 5 months old effective June 1, 1850, she would have been born sometime in January of that year. That places Eliza Jane's death sometime between January and June of 1850, and it's very possible that she died during childbirth, or from complications shortly thereafter.

Note: Attempts at tracing Eliza Jane's descendants have met with very limited success. She gave birth to six children before her death in 1850, and, as shown above, they were all named in the 1850 census. Ten years later, the names of two of her children, Mary R. and Nancy J., were absent from the 1860 census rolls, and it's likely that both girls were deceased. Nancy J. died as a baby sometime before October 16, 1851, because her name was not listed as a legal heir in Equity Suit No. 1847, which was filed after John Nichols' death in order to settle his estate. (For a complete review of that law suit, refer to the notes for Leroy Nichols in Chapter Thirteen). Mary would have been about 17 years old in 1860, and conceivably, she could have married and left home, but a check of marriage bonds and certificates for Barren and surrounding counties failed to turn up any documentation to support that idea. Despite considerable time and effort, the only additional information about Eliza Jane's children found anywhere in the public record pertains only to her oldest child, Martha Ann. The remaining children seem to have vanished completely.

Notes for ROBERT H. "BOBBY" LYONS:

After the death of Eliza Jane, Robert Lyons married twice again, and altogether fathered some 17 children. In 1851, he married Amanda Pulliam in Barren County, and after her death in 1866, he married her sister, Mary F. Pulliam, also in Barren County. The 1860 census for Barren County,

Kentucky listed R. H. Lyon, age 41, a farmer and head of the family, his wife, Mandy F., age 36, a daughter, Martha A., age 19, a son, W. J., age 15, a daughter, Susan E., age 13, a daughter, Merica, age 11, a son, D. L., age 9, a son, J. R., age 5, and a son, John Q., age 3 years. Also living in the home was M. E. Pulliam (sister-in-law). (Note: There is no mention of either Mary R. Lyon or Nancy J. Lyon, children of his first marriage with Eliza Jane Nichols, who would have been about 17 and 10 years old, respectively, in 1860. The 3 year old son, John Quincy Adams Lyons, was later taken in by Eliza Jane's brother, Leroy Nichols, and his wife, Peggy, who raised him to adulthood.)

The 1870 census for Sanders Precinct, Barren County, Kentucky listed Robert H. Lyon, age 51, head of the family and a farmer, his wife, Mary, age 41, a son, David L., age 17, Henry C., age 11, a daughter, Catherine, age 7, a daughter, Bettie, age 3, a daughter, Amanda, age 2, and a daughter, Leora E., age 2 months.

The 1880 U.S. Census for Waterloo District, Hart County, Kentucky listed Robert H. Lyon, age 61, a farmer and head of the household, his wife, Mary, age 49, a son, Hanobal C., age 18, a daughter, Bettie N., age 13, a daughter, Mandie, age 11, a daughter, Cara, age 9, a daughter, Darthula C., age 6, and a son, James R., age 5 months. (Note: The son, Hanobal, age 18, was probably from his second marriage with Amanda Pulliam.)

Notes for WILLIAM T. NICHOLS:

William T. Nichols married his first cousin, Martha Ann Lyons, on November 28, 1860, in Barren County, Kentucky. She was a daughter of his aunt, Eliza Jane Nichols, and Robert H. Lyons.

The 1870 census for Glasgow Precinct, Barren County, Kentucky listed William Nickols, age 38, a farmer and head of the household, his wife, Martha A., age 31, a son, Abner M., age 8, Joseph A., age 7, Martha J., age 4, and Sarah M., age 2. Also living in the home was James Lyons, age 15, who was Martha's half brother. The couple's real estate was valued at \$300 and their personal property at \$500. Living next door to William Nichols was his mother, Sarah Nichols, a 60 year old widow, along with three of his siblings who were still living at home, James, Leroy and Lucy. William's father, Abner K. Nichols, had died in October of 1867.

Martha Ann died sometime in the 1870's, leaving William with all five of their children still living at home. On February 28, 1878, William married for the second time to another first cousin, Lucy Nichols, a daughter of his uncle, Elias Nichols. At the time, Lucy Nichols was a 37 year old spinster still living at her parents home. Her father had died two years earlier, and her twin sister, Martha Jane, had recently married to Emmet Lawson. William and Lucy were married at the home of John Neese in Barren County. John Neese was Lucy Nichols' brother-in-law, the husband of her older sister, Sarah Elizabeth. Witnesses were Lucy's brother, James Riley Nichols and William S. Broady. (Marriage Certificate No. ___, Barren County, Kentucky Circuit Court Clerk.) Unfortunately, Lucy Nichols, herself, died within two years of her marriage, because by the 1880 census, William Nichols is listed as a widower. The cause of her death is not known.

It appears that sometime in the spring of 1880, after the death of his second wife, William Nichols decided to leave Barren County and move to the state of Illinois. In a deed dated April 13, 1880, William purchased a tract of land containing 11 and 3/4 acres from his brother, Lee Nichols for the sum of \$60. The tract was located on the waters of Beaver Creek approximately 6 miles east of Glasgow in Barren County and known as the Slayton land. (Deed Book 15, page 60). William then sold to Josiah Reynolds a parcel of land containing 72 acres for the sum of \$300 cash and recorded in a deed also dated April 13, 1880. The tract was located on the waters of Beaver Creek and also known as the Slayton land. (Deed Book 15, page 66.) It is probable that the 11 and 3/4 acre tract purchased from his brother was included in the 72 acre tract sold to Reynolds.

In another deed dated April 17, 1880, William Nichols conveyed his undivided 1/9 interest in his father's estate to his brother, Lee Nichols, for the sum of \$100. The deed was not officially recorded until April 26, 1886.

After settling his affairs in Barren County, William Nichols and his five children moved to Sangamon County, Illinois. Accompanying him on the move to Illinois were his sister, Susan F. Nichols and her husband, P. B. Nichols, and their five children. The two families settled near each other in Talkington Township.

The 1880 census for Talkington Township, Sangamon County, Illinois listed W. T. Nicholls, age 45, a widower, a farmer and head of the household, his son, Abner, age 18, working on the farm, a son, Joe, age 17, working on the farm, a daughter, Marta, age 13, keeping house, a daughter, Sarah M., age 11, and a son, James, age 10.

According to his headstone, William T. Nichols died in Sangamon County, Illinois in the year 1899 and is buried in West Cemetery located near the village of Thayer, Illinois.

The 1900 U.S. Census for Talkington Township, Sangamon County, Illinois, listed "Absalom" Nichols, age 38, a farmer, renting his home, his wife, Alice, age 30, a son, Willie, age 4, and a daughter, Dora, age 1 year. (Note: He was called "Abb," and the census record incorrectly identified him as Absalom). Listed in the same census as living nearby were the following relatives: living in a separate household were his brother, James, age 27, and his sister, Maggie, age 29; in another household was the family of his uncle, John D. Nichols, along with his wife and two children; his first cousin, Robert Nichols, and his family; shown as living alone was P. B. Nichols (now widowed), a son of John Nichols, Jr.; and, finally, Stephen Nichols and his family, a son of P. B. Nichols.

Ten years later, the family was still living in the same township in Sangamon County. The 1910 U.S. Census listed Abb Nichols, age 48, a farmer and Head of Household, his wife, Alice, age 38, a son, Willie E., age 15, a daughter, Dora, age 11, a daughter, Nola, age 8, and a son, Archie T., age 4. The census record indicates that the couple had had a total of nine children, but only four had survived.


